Statement of Belief

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (II Timothy 3:15, II Peter 1:21).
2. We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1, Matthew 28:19, John 10:30).
3. We believe in the deity of Christ (John 5:16-30), His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35), His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26), His miracles (John 2:11) his vicarious and atoning death (I Corinthians 5:3; Ephesians 1:7, Hebrews 2:9), His resurrection (John 11:25, I Corinthians 5:4), His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19), and His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11).
4. We believe that man was originally created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26-27), but fell through disobedience (Genesis 3). We believe in the absolute necessity of the regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because all men are born with a sinful nature and are justified on the single ground of faith by God's grace through the shed blood of Christ. (John 3:16-19, Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:8-9, Titus 3:5).
5. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28-29)
6. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9, I Corinthians 12:12-13, Galatians 3:26-28).
7. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13-14, I Corinthians 3:16, 6:19-20, Ephesians 4:30, 5:18).

Cooperation Agreement

Faith and Doctrine

As a non-denominational Christian school representing a cross section of evangelical churches in the Coulee Region, the Board of Coulee Christian School has adopted the following Doctrinal Policy in two parts:

1. Statement of Faith

The positive, fundamental truths essential to the Christian faith are contained in the Coulee Christian Statement of Belief. All board members, teachers, administrators, staff, and parent are required to adhere to the Statement of Faith.

2. Topics to be referred to home and church:

The following topics will not be taught at Coulee Christian School:

- Doctrines of the Eternal Security of the Believer
- Doctrines of Baptism
- Doctrines of the Charismatic Movement
- Doctrines of the End Times

While these doctrines might come up in class discussion, be referred to by a Chapel speaker, or be briefly replied to by a teacher, it is not the intent of Coulee Christian School to engage in protracted teaching upon these topics.

Teachers, administrators, and staff are requested to refer these four doctrinal topics to the home and/or church.

All international students attending Coulee Christian are expected to take Bible Class, attend Chapel, and will likely attend church services with their host family.

Students will stay with host families. International students agree to respect the authority of the host parents.
